Delta Air Lines, Northwest, & United out of Bankruptcy and needing pilots!

ATLANTA, GA – Delta Air Lines along with Northwest and United will be joining 39 other carriers from around the world in recruiting pilots during AIR, Inc.'s Airline Pilot Job Fair in Washington, DC on September 22, 2007. Due to the demands of their flying schedules, network restructuring, international expansion, and the availability of pilots (reduced since 9/11), many airlines are scrambling to find pilots. In order to attract pilots, some airlines are lowering their minimums while others are offering bonuses as large as \$2,500.

“The main reason we conduct our forums is to provide a networking opportunity between prospective airline pilots and airline recruiters,” said Kit Darby, President of AIR, Inc. “We provide the pilots with information on what’s going on in the industry, prepare them for a job with the airlines, and then give them the opportunity to meet key representatives of those airlines actively hiring.
